They worked hard to use alliteration in their sentences. On Thursday afternoon the children were learning about the inventor John Dunlop in their science lesson. The children spent the afternoon investigating different types of tyres and whether they make a bike easier to ride or not. Can the children remember what he invented? Can you find out any interesting facts about him?

#### Juniper Class

We've had a great week in Juniper class, we started off the week with writing up our own edited version of our story of 'August and His Smile' where we had some incredible ideas of where Augustus went to, using some brilliant alliteration to describe the area. Next, in maths we have been looking at partitioning a number to be able to subtract beneath a 10, can your child tell you what 34 - 17 is? Finally, in science we were exploring the properties of rubber and learnt all about John Dunlop who invested the pneumatic tyre, we have lots of fun experimenting on bikes and scooters so we could compare the two types of tyres. Well done for a great week Junipers.

#### The Dunes Class

This week in the Dunes, we have begun to learn about our planet. We learnt that the Earth is a sphere, made up of a core, mantle and crust. We are making a big tissue paper Earth to show this! We all enjoyed getting really muddy at Forest School, and splashing in the huge puddle. We have also made our own playdough!
